Dr. John Segreti is the Senior Attending Physician in the Department of Internal Medicine at Rush University Medical Center, as well as Professor at Rush Medical College in Chicago, Illinois. After receiving his medical degree from Rush Medical College, he went on to complete a residency at Rush-Presbyterian-St. Luke's Medical Center, eventually attaining the status of Chief Resident. His residency was followed by an Infectious Diseases fellowship at the same institution.

Dr. Segreti's research interests include antimicrobial resistance and nosocomial infections. Dr. Segreti has an extensive publication record with over 80 articles published in peer-reviewed journals as well as several book chapters on infectious diseases and the appropriate use of antimicrobials. Recently, Dr. Segreti has been involved in the development of clinical management guidelines released by the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons on the diagnosis of periprosthetic joint infections of the hip and knee (2011). Among his professional awards, Dr. Segreti has received the Department of Internal Medicine Teaching and Service Award at Rush-Presbyterian-St. Luke's Medical Center.
