Dr. Thomas J. He is involved in clinical trials of new antimicrobial agents and biologic response modifiers in seriously ill patients with infections, as well as selected aspects of clinical infectious diseases and clinical microbiology as it applies to antimicrobial utilization of home IV and diagnostic tests. Dr. Louie is also interested and knowledgeable about the application of fecal microbiota transplantation for the treatment of recurrent *Clostridium difficile* infection and has completed over 100 procedures.

Dr. Louie graduated from the University of Alberta Medical School, Calgary, AB, Canada and interned at the Vancouver General Hospital. He completed internal medicine training in Calgary and at UCLA, followed by infectious diseases training at UCLA and Tufts University School of Medicine.
