Dr. Ginsberg received his B.A. from the University of California, Berkeley and his M.D. at the University of Southern California (USC), where he also stayed for his urology residency. Dr. Ginsberg was a member of the AUA Urology Core Curriculum Section for Neuropathic Bladder and is a present member of the AUA/ABU Examination Committee.

Dr. Ginsberg's present research interests focus on lower urinary tract reconstruction in SCI patients, urologic applications of botulinum toxin and long-term follow-up issues for patients with neurogenic bladder. Dr. Ginsberg is the author or co-author of over 50 peer-reviewed articles, numerous book chapters and is a regular reviewer for journals such as *Journal of Urology, Urology, Neurourology and Urodynamics* and *Neurosurgery*. He is on the urological editorial board for *Neurourology and Urodynamics*.
