Dr. Stephan Foster retired as a professor from the University of Tennessee College of Pharmacy, however, continues his consulting work in the area of vaccines. He is also a retired Captain from the US Public Health Service.

Dr. Foster has personally trained thousands of immunizers and through his work with student pharmacists has facilitated the vaccination of more than 10,000 Tennesseans. His collaboration within and outside of pharmacy has led to his 2006 appointment by the governor of Tennessee to chair a committee on cervical cancer prevention. The state also has used his knowledge and skills in the development and implementation of its pandemic preparedness plan. Dr. Foster has served as the American Pharmacists Association (APhA) liaison representative on the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) since 2001-2021.
