Dr. Jason Gallagher is Clinical Professor at Temple University School of Pharmacy and Clinical Pharmacy Specialist in Infectious Diseases at Temple University Hospital, where he maintains a clinical practice. He also is the Director of the PGY2 Residency in Infectious Diseases Pharmacy at Temple and the Editor-in-Chief for *Contagion*.

Dr. Gallagher graduated with a Doctor of Pharmacy from Rutgers University in 2001. He then completed residency programs in Pharmacy Practice at Virginia Commonwealth University – Medical College of Virginia Hospital and in Infectious Diseases at Duke University Medical Center. He is a past President of the Society of Infectious Diseases Pharmacists, a past President of the Mid-Atlantic College of Clinical Pharmacy, and former Chair of the ACCP Infectious Diseases Practice and Research Network. Dr. Gallagher is also currently serving on the Board of Pharmacy Specialties Infectious Diseases Specialty Council. He is a co-author of four editions of *Antibiotics Simplified*, co-editor of three editions of *Frequently Prescribed Medications*, and the author of over 150 publications, abstracts, and book chapters. He is a Fellow of the American College of Clinical Pharmacy, the Society of Infectious Diseases Pharmacists, and the Infectious Diseases Society of America.
